

Oregon 4-H Strategic Action Plan – April 2016

Volunteer Development

Action 1: Continue to develop resources and compile them for a consistent state-wide New 4-H Volunteer Orientation (Indicators 1, 2 and 3)

- Compile (print) resources that address county staff requests
- Develop brief (10 minute or less) corresponding power point presentations
- Create lesson plans that reflect national 4-H volunteer development framework and include engaging adult learning principles
- Outline and produce brief videos that support New 4-H Volunteer Orientation plan
- Introduce this resource to staff during a Monthly Meet-Up
- Offer a more in depth introduction for staff, to the New Volunteer Orientation

Action 2: Work with 4-H colleagues in Western Region to revise and post Volunteer e-Learning Modules which will be available to supplement Oregon's 3-hour requirement for New Volunteer Training (Indicators 1, 2, and 3)

- A core Western Region committee will meet in May to develop scripts
- A company will be hired to fully develop e-modules to be compatible with the national 4-H online.
- Videos can be produced to support the e-modules
- Oregon staff will be introduced to the e-modules via a Monthly Meet-Up in October 2016
