Read the "Fashion Revue" section of the State Fair Book for details. (Note county quotas)

All Fashion Revue contestants will be entered through Showworks and scheduled when the county office contacts Sara Miller at the State 4-H office and will be done on a first come first served basis using the electronic form provided at: ??????????

### Procedure:

- \* Print Fashion Revue Information Cards from the website: <http://oregon.4h.oregonstate.edu/fair-exhibit-and-contest-materials>
- \* Send letter and Information Card to Fashion Revue participants.
- \* Select alternates for the contests when the county contest is held, so if the members chosen can not attend State Fair, the alternates can get the information and attend instead. Please do this re-scheduling as early in the month of August as possible.
- \* Note that the **schedule for participation is two days**. Therefore, participants will need **two daily passes** unless they are staying overnight in the dorm.
- \* **Participants need to bring with them:**
  - \_\_\_ completed information card with fabric samples of their garment
  - \_\_\_ photo or newspaper clipping showing them in their garment
  - \_\_\_ brief typed narrative on a card or paper (5" X 8" in size) for reading during public revue
  - \_\_\_ garments and accessories they will be modeling
- \* Send chaperon letter (in "Adult Supervision" section of this handbook) to the appropriate person attending State Fair with your participants.

Congratulations on being selected to participate in the Oregon State Fair. The first step is to schedule when you will participate. The contest is a two day event and is held both weekends of the fair (one Fri-Sat, the other Sat-Sun). Your participation date is scheduled with the State 4-H office through your county office. Please contact your county 4-H office to schedule your date. Your county office will provide you with gate passes (you will need two, one for each day unless you are staying in the dorms). Parking is free but can be quite full so give yourself plenty of time to find a parking spot. In addition most parking is quite a distance from the 4-H building so plan walking time into your schedule.

**Bring with you to the event:**

1. Fabric samples – labeled skirt, blouse, shirt, jacket, etc.
2. A picture of you in your garment.
3. The Fashion Revue information card (fill out front side only and include swatches of your fabric).
4. A typed narration suitable for reading while you are modeling at the public revue. Must be on a 5"x 8" card or paper. The typed commentary should be 100-175 words.

There will be a designated location to change clothes and/or fix hair makeup in the 4-H building, be aware this location may not be secure so please do not leave valuables.

Registration begins at 10:00am for intermediates and at 3:00pm for seniors on the first day of the contest. Members need to meet at the stage in the 4-H building at this time for orientation. They will then sign up for a time to do their interview judging (Intermediates 10am-3pm, Seniors 3pm-7pm). The public show is the following day at 1:30pm. Friends and family are welcome to attend all parts of the event.

**Exhibits on Display**

Please be aware you are not allowed to use anything submitted for display and/or judging at the State Fair in your Fashion Revue. That includes clothing, jewelry, knitting, anything. All displayed items are to remain on display during the entire duration of the fair and cannot be accessed/removed even for a short time.
