

## 4-H HERDSMANSHIP CONTEST SCORE SHEET

Herdsmanship is the way members display their animals. The contest should be judged as a spectator would view the display. Criteria to be considered are:

### MEMBERS (40 points)

Observed when present; member's continuous attendance in exhibit area not required.

- Appearance (neat, clean, suitably dressed)
- Cooperation (between members and with leaders, fairground management, and other clubs)
- Courtesy, cooperation, friendliness, positive attitude
- Work done by members
- Stall cards (neat and complete)
- Decorations appropriate

### ANIMALS (30 points)

- Clean and comfortable
- Regularly fed and cared for
- Securely and safely tied, penned or stalled
- Horses unsaddled in stalls

### BARN AREA (30 points)

- Clean and orderly
- Alleys, stalls, pens (cleaned regularly, well bedded)
- Feed and equipment (securely and safely stored)
